

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,  
NOVEMBER 22, 2005, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius, Inc.

Blasius made a motion to approve the minutes of the October meeting. This motion was seconded by Bergdolt. Carried.

Blasius made a motion to approve the minutes of the Election Commission Meeting. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler read the Planning Commission minutes. Bishop made a motion requesting clarification from the Planning Commission regarding the grandfathered business of Mike and Linda Cooper. Bergdolt will present this request to the Planning Commission. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

The Board of Appeals meeting on October 26, 2005, resulted in granting a variance.

The Zoning Board of Appeals will set two meetings a year that will be held in March and September and will give at least six weeks notice before holding the meeting.

The VAAS minutes and TCED minutes are on file.

Schmandt thanked the board for flowers received because of the death of his father.

Schmandt submitted his quarterly report and blight list report.

Fackler reported that the Eastman case had been dismissed because of progress. This must be completed by November 28, 2005. The attorney has sent a letter regarding the Itter property and Fackler authorized attorney to continue proceedings.

Fackler reported that the alarm system has been completed at the old hall.

Blasius will be contact person for the Tuscola County Economic Development.

The T.C.R.C. has asked for proposed road work by December 16, 2005. Fackler will contact them asking for more time.

Fackler will contact Earl Begg and request a copy of the current revision of the sign ordinance for review at the December meeting.

Bills were submitted in the amount of \$25,438.62. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes-Bishop, Fackler, Olson, Bergdolt, and Blasius.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 P.M.
