

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,  
JULY 18, 2006, 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

Fackler added item d., electric door opener, to New Business.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the June 20, 2006, minutes and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

No minutes were available from the Planning Commission.

Schmandt distributed the Zoning Administrator's quarterly report. Schmandt reported that the township has issued fewer permits this year. The blight list for July was distributed.

Fackler reported that he has been pursuing the various avenues of funding police protection and will try to present the same at the August meeting.

Fackler stated that the township is using the current Land Division ordinance and the new Land Division Application. This will be re-visited next year.

The City of Vassar, Vassar Twp., and Tuscola Twp. will have a joint meeting September 28, 2006, at the Tuscola Township Hall.

The Vassar Fire Agreement was distributed and discussed. This agreement was tabled for further study and to obtain specific answers to questions not yet revealed.

Members of the Tuscola Citizen's Council were present. Doug Wischmeyer expressed his thanks for the help the township had provided this past year. He reported that the ball season had a total of 462 children enrolled. He stated that he has the opportunity to pursue another grant for a covered pavilion in front of the concession stand. After some discussion, it was determined that the pavilion would be a great addition to the park area. The township board expressed appreciation for the work that has been accomplished this past year with regard to the ball program.

The monthly report of the Tuscola County Board of Commissioners was distributed.

Fackler reported that the quarterly meeting of the Tuscola County Chapter of MTA will be held on July 27, 2006, at 7:00 p.m. at the Fairgrove Township Hall.

Blasius reported that a possibility exists to receive a grant to install an electric door opener on the township hall. Fackler made a motion to have Blasius pursue the

installation of the electric door opener by means of a grant or otherwise. This motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$26,637.22. It was moved by Olson and seconded by Blasius to approve these bills for payment. Roll call: Yes-Bishop, Fackler, Olson, Bergdolt and Blasius.

Blasius will research portable tables and bring information to the August meeting.

After some discussion concerning the master copy of the Tuscola Township Zoning Ordinances, it was determined that the Planning Commission will be asked to provide the board with the most recent, up-to-date copy.

The township board worked on the Freedom of Information Policy.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 p.m.
