

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP
BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2006, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Olson and Blasius. Absent; John Bishop.

Gerald Peterson, county commissioner, was placed at the beginning of the agenda to bring the board up to date on the Sirolli Institute.

Olson made a motion to approve the October 17th minutes and this motion was seconded by Fackler. Carried.

Peterson was present to inform the board of the county's plan to engage the services of the Sirolli Institute to work with entrepreneurs in the county to provide new jobs and services. This has been successfully implemented in various areas. Grants have been applied for and Peterson is asking the township to consider a donation of \$700.00 per year to continue this program after the initial two years. This will be addressed at the budget meeting in January.

Fackler made a motion to approve the October 17th minutes of the Election Commission and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler read the minutes of the Planning Commission.

Schmandt distributed the blight list for November.

Blasius made a motion to accept the Waste Management one year extension of services and the additional charges. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler reported that the Parks and Recreation grants will be selected on December 5th.

Bergdolt made a motion to request bids for the following roads for work to be completed in 2007 and this motion was seconded by Olson: VanCleve, Hart to Richville, Lorenzo, Simpson to Waterman, Richville, Truax to Weaver and Richville, Simpson to Waterman. Carried.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$28,455.63. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call vote: yes-Bergdolt, Olson, Blasius and Fackler.

Blasius made a motion to adjust the budget in the following areas: \$350.00 from Land Acquisition to Clerk Expenses, \$900.00 from Land Acquisition to Elections, \$500.00 from Land Acquisition to Grounds Keeper, \$200.00 from Land Acquisition and \$3050

from Land Acquisition to Recreation Program. This motion was seconded by Bergdolt.
Carried.
