

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP
BOARD HELD ON MONDAY, APRIL 16, 2007, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:15 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop and Blasius. Absent: Olson.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the minutes of the March meeting and this motion was seconded by Fackler. Carried.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the minutes of the Budget Hearing Meeting and this motion was seconded by Fackler. Carried.

Fackler stated that the VAAS minutes are on file.

Schmandt distributed pictures of a utility building on the property of Dennis Welhi located at 1051 Day Rd. Dennis Welhi was present and after some discussion Schmandt will issue a permit at no charge because of the size of the structure. Schmandt also distributed a copy of the Blight List.

Bergdolt made a motion to accept the parking lot bid of \$152,802.65 from MacFarlane Excavating. This motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried. The project will begin on August 1, 2007, and will be completed in approximately three weeks.

Garold Law was present to express his concern over the blowing sand from the tree farm located next to his property on Buell Rd. The township has no ordinance regarding this problem. The owners of the tree farm will be contacted to see if a suitable resolution to this problem can be implemented.

The locust tree proposal will be tabled until further notice.

Tuscola County Road Commission sent notification that if the township desires to have spraying done on any township road, residents will have to be notified and allowed to deny the spraying of their property. Schmandt will note any areas that are in need of spraying after the trees are leafed out.

Fackler noted that the Gilford Township Board will host an open house at their new facility on May 7, 2007, from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$17,027.51. It was noted that this did not include the payroll for the members of the various boards. Blasius made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Roll call vote: yes-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop and Blasius. The total of the bills after payroll was included totaled \$20,289.24.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
