

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP
BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2007, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on October 15, 2007, upon the insertion of the word be in the third paragraph from the bottom which reads: This will be forwarded on to the Parks and Recreation Board. This motion was seconded by Olson. Bishop abstained. Carried.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting held on Monday, November 5th, 2007, and this motion was seconded by Olson. Blasius corrected the date of the meeting which read 2006 to 2007. Carried. The minutes of the closed session are attached.

Kim Bishop was present as our representative to the Vassar Ambulance Board to explain Denmark Township's position regarding the Vassar Ambulance.

Fackler stated the minutes of the Tuscola County Economic Development Board are on file.

Schmandt distributed the November blight list.

Fackler stated that the T.C.R.C. will be replacing the Main St. culvert and the Fourth St. catch basin at no extra charge to the township.

Fackler reported that Worth Construction will do the clean up of the foundation, remove unburned debris, fill and level area of lot located on Van Cleve Rd. for a total of \$2,200.00. Blasius made a motion to accept this estimate and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Blasius will contact the City of Vassar to have the Truck Ordinance sign replaced on Cottrell Rd.

Cyril Haines reported that a new light on the hall will be \$180.00 plus labor to install.

Peterson was present and reported on the Sirolli program and the progress of this project.

Fackler reported that the VFW and Auxiliary have requested permission to place a wreath at the cemetery on December 15, 2007. This will be done the same day at all cemeteries. This request was granted.

Fackler reported that the Richville Community Fire Association will be levying a \$100.00 assessment for all addresses in the Richville Fire District

After some discussion, the township board will ask for bids for 2008 road work on the following roads: Van Cleve, Hart to Richville, Lorenzo, Simpson to Waterman, Hecht, Simpson to Waterman, Richville, Truax to Weaver, Richville, Simpson to Waterman and Van Cleve, Reese to Hart.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$95,983.09. It was moved by Olson and seconded by Blasius to accept these bills for payment. Roll Call: Yes-Olson, Blasius, Bergdolt, Bishop and Fackler.

Olson made a motion to authorize Cyril Haines to purchase a leaf removal system not to exceed \$2,000 and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
