

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2009, AT
7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

No new items were added to the agenda.

Bushong made a motion to approve the minutes of the November meeting and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Nicole Shelters who lives at 976 W. Huron Ave. was present to lodge a complaint regarding the noise level of the new teen dance club, Club Jam'n that is very close to her home. After some discussion, Fackler recommended that she attend the Planning Commission and voice her concerns.

Fackler read the Planning Commission minutes.

Bushong reported that the Parks and Recreation are exploring the feasibility of lighting the largest ball field. They will be meeting on January 4, 2010, to prepare their 2010-2011 budget.

Schmandt reported that no violation letters have been sent because it is the Christmas season.

Bushong made a motion to consult with our attorney concerning a special license for the Patricks with regard to the property line that borders the west of the township. This license could be revoke at any time, no new structures could be built and it would be only for the current owners. This motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Fackler reported that a grant for the Cass River Greenway was approved. The township's portion will be \$32,700, Frankenmuth's portion will be \$35,300 and Vassar's portion will be \$15,400. This project will be completed in 2010.

Fackler stated that he will attend a FEMA meeting concerning the preliminary flood insurance study and flood rate map on December 16, 2009, in Caro.

Fackler reported that the T.C.R.C. will be billing Eugene Palmreuter for damages done to approximately 30 square feet of asphalt on Hecht Road that resulted from equipment exiting the field.

Fackler reported that he will be meeting with the Richville Fire Department after the first of the year.

The township tax maps need to be updated. Fackler will obtain the estimate from Great Lakes Mapping and bring to the January meeting.

Fackler will be ordering a partial chemistry kit for the 4th quarter for the testing of the township well.

Fackler reported a Task Force 7A Meeting that will be held on December 22, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. at the T.C.R.C. This meeting will result in designating a priority list for projects to be funded with Federal and State monies on the county level.

Fackler will investigate a complaint of a sink hole in a ditch located beside McPherson Street. There is currently a fence around the hole.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$10,776.65. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Roll call: yes-Blasius, Fackler, Olson, Bishop and Bushong.

The budget work session will be held on Monday, February 15, 2010, at 7:00 p.m.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
