

MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 19, 2010, AT
7:00 P.M.

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Fackler, Bishop and Blasius. Absent-Olson

Fackler added sink hole, item E, under unfinished business. Bushong made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Bushong made a motion to approve the December minutes and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Fackler read the December 2nd minutes of the Planning Commission and the minutes of the December 2nd Public Hearing. There was some discussion concerning the teen dance club, Club Jam'n, and a request to monitor the noise level has been given to the county road patrol.

Bushong reported that the Parks and Recreation Board will be presenting their 2010-2011 budget to the township board on February 15th budget work shop. He also stated that the Parks and Recreation Board will meet the 1st Monday of each quarter this year.

Schmandt distributed the 2009 Final Zoning Administrator's report that included 24 permits, 3 new homes and 43 blight letters. He also submitted a report showing the activity the past five years.

Abbey reported to Fackler that Palmreuter has obtained an attorney and Chapman's court date is January 20th. Schmandt will check in the morning to see if the pickup has been moved and will contact the attorney with this information.

Fackler will be attending the Cass River Greenway Water Trail Development meeting on January 20th in Vassar.

Fackler reported that there will be much benefit to the township from the Flood Rate Maps.

The sink hole problem will be tabled until the February meeting so Fackler can observe the situation.

Fackler stated that the next meeting of the Richville Fire Department will be held on January 26, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. After some discussion, it was the consensus of the township board

that it is in the best interest of the township to have two members from our township on the Richville Fire Department Board.

Fackler reported that the township well passed both tests.

Fackler also reported that Republic Waste is increasing their rates to \$10.38 per unit which is \$124.56 per household yearly. It was suggested that a representative attend our February meeting to address some of the issues that have occurred recently.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$12,727.19. Blasius made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Roll call: yes-Fackler, Bushong, Blasius and Bishop.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
