

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, JULY 20,
2010, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by Blasius in the absence of Fackler at 7:10 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Bishop, Olson and Blasius. Absent-Fackler.

Olson made a motion to accept the minutes of the June meeting as written and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

Schmandt distributed the Zoning Administrator's 2nd Quarterly Report and the July Blight List.

After some discussion, Bishop made a motion to turn properties at 7096 Vassar Rd. and 4660 Cottrell Rd. over to our attorney because of high weeds. This motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

Olson reported that several properties in the township were going to be put up for tax sale and the township would have the option of purchasing them for the tax price. After some discussion and being advised that the township could never realize any profit from these properties, Bushong made a motion to not purchase these properties and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

The new agreement for fire protection services between Denmark Township and Tuscola Township was distributed and discussed. This agreement will be tabled until the August meeting.

David Erbisch stated that he has observed trash being thrown over the bank at the cemetery. Discussion ensued concerning how to prohibit this violation and Erbisch will check on cameras that could be placed at the cemetery. He will also take license numbers of those who are throwing the trash and this will be reported to the prosecutor.

The rating on the township roads were discussed and it was the consensus of the board that a township official and the engineer should ride at least some of the township roads that have been deemed poor to see how this rating was determined.

Olson made a motion to take \$2,000 from Contingency to Engineering and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$14,324.48. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes-Bishop, Bushong, Blasius and Olson.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
