

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2010, AT
7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

There was no written agenda.

Olson made a motion to accept the January 19th minutes as written and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

Shoens stated that the street light at Church and Elm has not been replaced and Olson will contact Detroit Edison concerning this situation.

Begg reported that the noise level from Club Jam'n has improved after the sheriff monitored the decibels. He also reported that July is the targeted date for the completion of the Zoning Ordinances.

Fackler read the minutes of the January 6th meeting of the Planning Commission.

The Vassar Area Ambulance Service will be hosting an open house at the Vassar Ambulance Base on March 18, 2010, from 6 P.M. to 7 P.M. to celebrate 30 years of service to the community.

Schmandt submitted pictures of the Chapman violation and stated that he has 13 vehicles on the 30 day list. Chapman did not appear for his court appointment.

The contract for David Erbisch will need to be corrected to read independent contractor in place of the word employee.

The attorney has requested a copy of the survey, legal name and address for the property adjacent to the ball park for the purpose of preparing a document to permit the usage of this area by the residents.

Fackler is on the agenda for a meeting with the Richville Fire Department Monday, February 22, 2010.

Fackler stated that there is nothing on the agenda for the Board of Appeals in March but there is a possibility of holding the meeting in April.

Fackler stated that the DEQ has closed our file for the proposed township pavilion.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$11,259.29. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Roll call: Yes-Fackler, Olson, Bishop, Blasius and Bushong.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 P.M.
