

**APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,
AUGUST 20, 2013, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Hicks, Fackler, Verbeek, Olson and Blasius.

Olson made a motion to approve the agenda as written and this motion was seconded by Verbeek. Carried.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of the July meeting and this motion was seconded by Hicks. Carried.

Kirkpatrick stated that a resident that resides close to the Ormes and Bray Road intersection inquired about the illuminating or making a four-way stop at this location. After some discussion concerning this intersection, Fackler suggested that residents concerned about this attend a Tuscola County Road Commission meeting.

Hicks reported on the June 5th Planning Commission meeting.

Fackler stated that the next Board of Appeals meeting will be October 16, 2013.

Fackler reported that the VAAS minutes for July 17th and the Bullard-Sanford Library minutes for July 18th are on file for review.

Verbeek stated that the next Parks and Recreation meeting will be held on Monday, September 9, 2013. The township picnic will be on Saturday, August 24th, at 12:00 noon.

Kirkpatrick stated that the Cass River Greenway would like to see signage on the river and will install two signs which state that a canoe launch is ahead and one at the site of the launch. After some discussion, the Parks and Recreation Board will work on signage on Van Cleve Road designating the canoe launch.

Fackler has contacted the state concerning the change of the enforcement of zoning to Construction Code Group and what will be necessary to implement this change.

Fackler reported that the township audit has been completed and copies of the reports are available to review upon request.

The township received two resumes to be considered for the position of township sexton.

Robert Traver and Wayne Nelson's resumes were reviewed by the board. After some discussion, Hicks made a motion to contract with Wayne Nelson for the sexton position. This motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.

Fackler reported that the township had received the report for July and a corrected report for June from AKT Peerless. The results are within an acceptable range.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$21,535.73. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes-Blasius, Hicks, Olson, Fackler and Verbeek.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
