

**APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,  
DECEMBER 17, 2013, AT 1:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by Trustee Robert Verbeek in the absence of the Supervisor at 1:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present- Hicks, Verbeek, Olson and Blasius. Absent- Fackler

Last month's agenda was approved to use as a guideline for this meeting.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of the November meeting and this motion was seconded by Hicks. Carried.

Erbisch inquired about the survey for the triangle piece of property owned by the township located on Van Cleve Rd. This will be referred to Fackler for his opinion.

After some discussion concerning the canoe launch, Blasius made a motion to have the Parks and Recreation Board post a sign on the gate that states the gate will be opened on April 1st and closed on November 1st. This motion was seconded by Hicks. Carried.

Spicer will be contacted concerning the Zoning Ordinance books and the process of obtaining a disc to have posted on the township web site.

Verbeek reported that the next meeting of the Parks and Recreation Board will be January 16, 2014.

The Zoning Administrator, Tom Asperger, distributed the Zoning Administrator Report for December. A letter was also distributed from the Tuscola County Health Department concerning a blight violation for property on Huron Ave.

Blasius reported that a Declaration of Intent had been filed at the Register of Deeds for the canoe launch property. All monies from this grant have been received.

**After some discussion concerning departing personnel, Hicks made a motion to issue a Certificate of Appreciation to all who have served the Township and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.**

**It was reported that the township did not receive the grant for the river walk this current year. Modifications will be completed and another grant application will be submitted before April 1, 2014.**

**The township's new telephone system has been installed.**

**The cemetery project is tabled until the January meeting.**

**Blasius made a motion to take \$150.00 from Contingency to Computers and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.**

**Bills were presented in the amount of \$15,638.11. Olson made a motion to approve these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll Call: Yes- Olson, Hicks, Blasius and Verbeek.**
