

**APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,  
JUNE 17, 2014, AT 1:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 1:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Hicks, Fackler, Verbeek, Olson and Blasius.

Olson made a motion to approve the agenda and this motion was seconded by Hicks.  
Carried.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of the May meeting and this motion was seconded by Verbeek. Carried.

Craig Kirkpatrick stated that the T.C.R.C. has received a grant in the amount of \$66,000.00 for lighting at the Bray and Ormes Rd. intersection. This work will be completed in 2015.

Kevin Daly, candidate for state senate, was present to give his resume and ask for support for the August 5, 2014, primary election.

Hicks reported on the Planning Commission meeting. The next meeting will be in August.

Verbeek reported that four members of the Parks and Recreation Board met with Amy Metistiff, grant coordinator from the DNR, on June 10th to walk the trail and discuss the upcoming possibility of a grant.

Fackler stated that the VAAS minutes are on file for review.

The Zoning Administrator, Tom Asperger, distributed the Zoning Administrator's Report for June.

Fackler reported that the Vassar Fire Agreement is still at the attorneys as well as the blight papers for property located at 7146 Sohn Rd.

After some discussion concerning the canoe launch, Fackler will contact Dave Erbisch to see if he needs additional help or equipment to keep the launch in good condition.

Blasius reported that the lights on the south side of the township hall will be replaced with more efficient LED lights and a spot light for the flag. The doors are in the process of being painted.

Fackler reported that Charlotte Peterson from the Zoning Board of Appeals had submitted a letter of resignation.

**Fackler reported that the water sample at the hall is satisfactory.**

**Blasius made a motion to accept the annual insurance renewal from Burnham and Flower and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.**

**Olson made a motion to accept the three year bid from Anderson, Tuckey, Bernhardt and Doran and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.**

**Fackler submitted a request from the US Bicycle Route 20 to place signs on various roads in Tuscola Township. The township will submit a letter to the T.C.R.C. requesting the specialty signs be installed. Fackler made a motion to approve this request and this motion was seconded by Hicks. Carried.**

**The City of Vassar sent a fire notice to the township for a grass fire located on Utter Rd. Fackler will contact the City for verification if the fire was in Tuscola Twp. or Vassar Twp.**

**Carol Smith submitted a request to attend a conference for continuing education for Citizens Planning. After some discussion and due to the cost of the conference, Fackler made a motion to deny this request and this motion was seconded by Verbeek. Carried.**

**Bills were presented in the amount of \$20,342.83. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes-Blasius, Verbeek, Fackler, Hicks and Olson.**
